Decision no. 7/2022 of the Warsaw University of Technology Rector of 20 January 2022

on the remote mode of teaching and verification of learning outcomes in the period from 24 January until 22 February 2022

Under Art. 23 section 1 of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Acts of 2021, item 478 as amended), in connection with § 1 section 2 point 2 of the WUT Rector's Regulation no. 110/2021 of 18 November 2021 on the functioning of the Warsaw University of Technology during the COVID-19 epidemic as of 19 November 2021, it is resolved as follows:

§ 1

- 1. In the period from 24 January to 22 February 2022:
 - 1) the basic mode of teaching at the Warsaw University of Technology shall be the remote mode;
 - 2) verification of learning outcomes, including tests, project presentations and other forms of taking credits shall be conducted remotely;
 - 3) examinations in the winter examination period shall be conducted remotely.
- 2. The stipulations included in section 1 do not require amendments to course regulations.
- 3. In justified cases, on the request of the head of the basic organizational unit, the Rector may take the decision to conduct courses and verification of learning outcomes in other forms than those specified in section 1, upon consultation with the Team for coordination of preventive measures at the Warsaw University of Technology related to potential covid-19 infection risk.

§ 2

The decision shall apply to participants of post-graduate studies and other forms of education conducted at WUT.

§ 3

The Decision shall enter into force on the day of its signing.
